

Pharma Export Contract

Pharma, Chemicals & Life Sciences

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a pharma export contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering products and specs, quality and COA, price and Incoterm, payment (LC), delivery and shelf-life, regulatory responsibility, liability and recall, and governing law and arbitration. Use this for a solid export supply contract. Have it reviewed by an export or legal expert.

Purpose of this tool & output

A solid contract for pharma exports

How the output is used

Use the draft to contract a pharma export deal with clear Incoterms, payment, quality and regulatory-responsibility terms, then have a lawyer review it.

Who receives it

The Indian exporter (you) and the overseas buyer/importer — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; export deals also involve bank/LC documentation rather than a government filing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer for the Incoterms, payment-security (LC) and regulatory-responsibility clauses; a CHA or export consultant on trade terms.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; have it reviewed by an export or legal expert.
