Background

Builds a pharma inventory management approach — batch and expiry tracking, FEFO, near-expiry handling, reorder and storage conditions — with expiry control (alerts, returns) and controls (reconciliation, temperature). Use this to control stock, expiry and batches per GDP. For retail-pharmacy-specific control use the Pharmacy Inventory & Expiry Control tool.
