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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a GHS-aligned Safety Data Sheet (SDS) structure — all 16 sections from identification and hazards through handling, storage, exposure controls, toxicology, disposal, transport and regulatory info — with GHS classification and labelling notes. Use this to structure a compliant SDS. Content must be technically accurate and GHS-compliant.

Use the builder to structure a compliant safety data sheet for a chemical with all sixteen sections.
