Background

Builds a compliance self-audit for a retail pharmacy — area by area (licence and pharmacist, storage, dispensing and registers, expiry, records, billing) with checks, a Compliant/Gap/Critical scorecard and priority fixes. Use this to self-audit your pharmacy against the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules.

Use it to self-audit your retail pharmacy against drug-licence conditions and to close gaps before a drug-inspector visit.

Who should vet it

A registered pharmacist familiar with your state drug-licence conditions.
