

Supply Agreement Draft

Pharma, Chemicals & Life Sciences

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a pharma supply agreement — a clause-by-clause draft covering products and specs, pricing, quality and COA, delivery, batch and expiry, returns, liability and recall, and term and termination, with schedules. Use this for supply terms with buyers or institutions. Have it reviewed by a lawyer.

Purpose of this tool & output

Supply terms with buyers or institutions

How the output is used

Use the draft to set supply terms with a buyer or institution — specification, price, delivery and quality — and have a lawyer review it before signing.

Who receives it

The supplier (you) and the buyer or institution — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state on the agreement; no government filing is needed.

Who should vet it

A lawyer for the quality, rejection and payment-security clauses; QA on the specification terms.

Important cautions

AI-generated template; have it reviewed by a lawyer before signing.
