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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds an equipment and backup checklist for a shoot — cameras, lenses, lights, batteries, cards, and critically backup bodies/cards/batteries — so gear failure never ruins an irreplaceable shoot. Use it before every shoot. For data safety use the On-Shoot Data Backup & Safety tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Never reach a shoot without vital gear

How the output is used

Use it to never reach a shoot without vital gear — an equipment and backup checklist for every shoot type.

Important cautions

Always carry backup gear (second body, spare batteries/cards) — equipment failure at a once-in-a-lifetime wedding is unrecoverable; charge everything, pack enough cards, and verify the kit before leaving.
