

Post-Production Quality Control

Photography & Videography

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a post-production quality-control process — checking edited photos/films for consistency, completeness (all key moments/must-haves included), technical quality and client-brief match before delivery — so every delivery meets your standard and disputes are avoided. Use it to assure quality. For editing use the Photo Editing Workflow tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Ensure every delivery meets your standard

How the output is used

Use it to ensure every delivery meets your standard — a post-production quality control checklist before handover.

Important cautions

A QC gate before delivery (cross-checking the shot list/brief for completeness and consistency) prevents the missed-key-moment and inconsistent-edit complaints; never deliver without this final check.
