

Shoot Planning & Shot List

Photography & Videography

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds a shoot plan and shot list — the must-have shots, sequence and timing, locations and light, and crew assignments — for a specific shoot, so key moments are captured and the shoot runs to plan. Use it before any shoot. For wedding day flow use the Wedding Day Coverage SOP.

Purpose of this tool & output

Plan every shoot so nothing is missed

How the output is used

Use it to plan every shoot so nothing is missed — a shoot planning and shot list that covers every required frame.

Important cautions

A shot list (family/VIP groups, key rituals, must-haves) and clear crew assignments prevent the missed-moment regret that ruins wedding coverage; align portraits to golden-hour light and confirm the event schedule.
