Background

Plans a photography studio space — shooting area and backdrops/cyclorama, lighting setup, client meeting/viewing area, editing workstations, storage, and a look that impresses clients — so the space works for shoots and sells to clients. Use it to set up/upgrade a studio. For equipment use the Equipment Planning & Investment tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Design a functional, impressive studio space

How the output is used

Use it to design a functional, impressive studio space — a studio space setup and design guide across zones, light and client area.

Important cautions

A well-designed studio serves shoots AND sells — a nice client consultation/viewing area helps close bookings and album sales. Balance function (ceiling height, cyclorama, storage) against your budget and the shoot types you actually do in-studio.
