Background

Builds a multi-year cash-flow projection through the gestation and into bearing — establishment cost, upkeep during immaturity, yield build-up and cash turn-positive year. Use it to see the long cash burn and plan financing.

How the output is used

Use it to project cash through the gestation years — a gestation cash-flow projection that funds the estate until it yields.

Who should vet it

Your CA or banker, to confirm the gestation cash-flow against the crop maturity and funding plan.

Important cautions

A long-horizon projection highly sensitive to yield build-up, commodity price and cost over many years; the gestation trough is deep and long. Use conservative assumptions, secure financing with an adequate moratorium and buffer, and have a CA and lender review.
