How the output is used

Use it to test if a plantation venture is viable — the yield, gestation, price and cost economics before you commit land and capital.

Who should vet it

An agronomist and a CA, to confirm the yield, gestation and cost assumptions before you invest.

Important cautions

A desk feasibility view; plantation returns depend on yield build-up, long-run price and climate over many years and carry a long payback. Commission soil and climate assessment and local expert study before investing.
