

Pest & Disease Management Plan

Plantation & Commercial Crops

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Builds an integrated pest and disease management plan for a plantation crop — key pests and diseases, monitoring, cultural, biological and safe chemical control and residue compliance. Use it to protect the crop responsibly.

Purpose of this tool & output

Protect the crop with IPM

How the output is used

Use it to protect the crop with IPM — a pest and disease management plan that controls threats with integrated methods.

Important cautions

Not a prescription; pest and disease pressure and approved products change and residue limits are strict for export. Confirm approved products, doses and pre-harvest intervals with the board or research institute and comply with destination-market residue rules.
