

Working Capital Planner

Plantation & Commercial Crops

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Estimates working capital for a plantation from discrete cost-timing and receivable inputs — the cash tied up through upkeep and harvest before sale proceeds arrive. Use it to size a crop loan and avoid a cash crunch.

Purpose of this tool & output

Plan cash across the crop year

How the output is used

Use it to plan cash across the crop year — a working-capital planner across inputs, labour and the receipts gap.

Who should vet it

Your CA or banker, to confirm the working-capital need against your crop and payment cycles.

Important cautions

An estimate from your inputs; a poor harvest or price-led delay in selling can deepen and lengthen the cash need. Keep a buffer and arrange credit before the upkeep and harvest spend, and revisit with actual timings.
