Background

Get an Extended Producer Responsibility plan for a producer, importer or brand-owner using packaging — registration, target computation, fulfilment routes (recyclers/PROs, recycled content) and record-keeping — to stay compliant. Describe your packaging footprint below.

Register and meet EPR targets for packaging

How the output is used

Use it to register and meet EPR targets for packaging — the Extended Producer Responsibility registration and target fulfilment a packaging producer, importer or brand-owner needs.

Who receives it

The EPR registration is with the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) on the EPR portal under the Plastic Waste Management (EPR) rules.

How to submit / file it

Register as a producer, importer or brand-owner, declare packaging placed on the market, and file periodic returns meeting the recycling/EPR targets.

Fees & charges

Registration and the EPR obligation cost (credits or processing) per the rules; non-compliance attracts environmental compensation.

Who should vet it

An EPR consultant, to register correctly and reconcile the targets and returns with CPCB.

Important cautions
