Printing & Packaging

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Create a brief to produce a packaging mockup or prototype — what must be represented (structure, print, finishes), fidelity level, quantity and purpose (approval, photoshoot, testing) — so the sample serves its job. Describe the pack below.

Use it to get a realistic dummy before you commit — a mockup and prototype brief that catches issues before the run.

AI-generated brief; a mockup approximates but may not exactly match mass production.
