

DPCO Price Control Compliance

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a DPCO/price-control compliance guide — scheduled (price-capped) vs non-scheduled drugs, ceiling prices, no overcharging, MRP display and records. Use it to price and sell within NPPA/DPCO rules. For overall drug law use the Drug Law Compliance Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Comply with NPPA drug price control

How the output is used

Use it to comply with NPPA drug price control — how DPCO ceiling prices apply to scheduled formulations you sell.

Important cautions

Never sell any drug above its MRP, and scheduled (NLEM/DPCO) drugs not above the NPPA-notified ceiling price (plus GST) — overcharging on price-controlled drugs is a serious offence with recovery of the overcharged amount plus penalty. Check current notified ceiling prices for scheduled drugs. Confirm DPCO/NPPA rules; this is general guidance.
