Background

Analyses whether a specific pharmacy will be viable — prescriber-driven demand, competition, margins, working capital and break-even — with a go/no-go. Use it before committing. For the full plan use the Pharmacy Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Check if the pharmacy will pay

How the output is used

Use it to check if the pharmacy will pay — the footfall, prescription flow, margin and cost economics before you commit.

Who should vet it

An experienced pharmacist-owner and a CA, to sanity-check the footfall, margin and cost assumptions before you invest.

Important cautions

Prescriber proximity drives pharmacy footfall, and an entrenched competing chemist with doctor relationships is hard to displace. Inventory working capital is heavy and expiry is a real cost. Validate prescription demand and your ability to fund inventory before committing.
