Background

Produces a plan to support immunisation/vaccine services — vaccine cold-chain and stocking, tie-ups with doctors/clinics for administration, awareness and record-keeping — within the legal scope. Use it to add vaccine-related value. For cold chain use the Cold Chain Setup tool (P3).

How the output is used

Use it to support vaccination the right way — an immunisation and vaccine service support guide within cold-chain and legal limits.

Important cautions

Vaccines demand strict cold chain (never frozen) and, in India, administration is generally by qualified medical/nursing professionals — a pharmacy typically supplies vaccines and partners with a doctor/clinic/nurse rather than the pharmacist administering, unless specifically permitted. Confirm the legal scope for vaccine handling/administration locally before offering services.
