Produces an inventory-management system for a pharmacy — par levels across a wide SKU base, batch/expiry tracking, FEFO, fast/slow-mover control and working-capital efficiency. Use it to control stock and cut expiry. For expiry specifically use the Expiry Management tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Control a wide drug inventory and expiry

How the output is used

Use it to control a wide drug inventory and expiry — an inventory management system across SKUs, batches and reorder.

Important cautions

The pharmacy inventory challenge is balancing high availability (stock-outs lose patients) against expiry and heavy tied-up capital across thousands of SKUs — use movement analysis, FEFO, near-expiry monitoring and inventory software. Trim dead SKUs. Adapt to your patient demand.
