

Schedule H / H1 / X Compliance Guide

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a guide to handling scheduled drugs — Schedule H, H1, X and narcotics — prescription requirements, mandatory registers, storage and dispensing rules. Use it to dispense scheduled drugs compliantly. For the narcotic licence use the Narcotic Licence Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Dispense scheduled drugs legally

How the output is used

Use it to dispense scheduled drugs legally — how Schedule H, H1 and X drugs must be sold, recorded and controlled.

Important cautions

Prescription (Schedule H/H1/X) drugs must be dispensed only against a valid prescription, with the required registers (especially the Schedule H1 register for antibiotics/habit-forming drugs and Schedule X duplicate-prescription/lock-storage rules) maintained and retained — this is heavily inspected and violations are serious offences. Confirm current schedule requirements.
