

Pharmacy Setup Guide

Pharmacy & Chemist Retail

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a setup plan for a retail pharmacy — model, location, drug licence and pharmacist, store, stock and a launch checklist. Use it to start out. For the full plan use the Pharmacy Business Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Start a retail chemist or pharmacy

How the output is used

Use it as your first roadmap to open a retail chemist or pharmacy — the model, premises, licences and stock you need before you open.

Important cautions

A retail pharmacy legally requires a drug licence and a registered pharmacist (competent person) present — you cannot operate without them. Refrigerated drugs need proper cold chain. Location near hospitals/clinics/doctors drives prescription footfall. Confirm licence requirements with the state Drugs Control department.
