

Shops & Establishment / Local Registration

Pharmacy & Chemist Retail

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Produces a guide to Shops & Establishment registration and other local registrations for a pharmacy, plus the labour basics they trigger. Use it to register and employ staff legally. For deeper labour rules use the HR line tools.

Purpose of this tool & output

Register the pharmacy and meet basics

How the output is used

Use it to register the pharmacy and meet the basics — the Shops and Establishment registration and local requirements a chemist needs.

Who receives it

The State Labour Department (Shops & Establishment authority) / municipal body.

How to submit / file it

Register online on the state labour portal within the prescribed days of starting, with establishment and employee details.

Fees & charges

A state-specific fee based on employee count; renewal rules vary by state.

Who should vet it

A local labour-law consultant; requirements differ by state.

Important cautions

Shops & Establishment and local registrations vary by state/municipality. These are in addition to the mandatory drug licence and GST. Confirm the state process and watch EPF/ESI thresholds as staff grow; consult locally.
