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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Guides the board-affiliation journey — prerequisites (society/trust, land, recognition, infrastructure, staff), the stage-wise affiliation process and timeline, and common rejection reasons — so you plan affiliation realistically. Use it to understand the path. For the papers use the Affiliation Documentation Checklist.

Purpose of this tool & output

Navigate CBSE / ICSE / State board affiliation

How the output is used

Use the guide to navigate CBSE / ICSE / State board affiliation from eligibility to grant.

Who receives it

The affiliating board — CBSE, CISCE (ICSE) or the State board.

How to submit / file it

Apply on the board portal (e.g. CBSE SARAS/OASIS) with the state NOC, recognition, land and infrastructure documents; a mandatory inspection follows.

Fees & charges

Board affiliation and inspection fees (as prescribed by the board).

Who should vet it

An education-affiliation consultant.

Important cautions

Affiliation bye-laws and norms are detailed and change; confirm current requirements on the target board portal (e.g. CBSE) before applying.
