Background

Builds board bye-laws compliance and inspection-readiness — the recurring obligations under affiliation bye-laws (infrastructure, safety, staff, records, disclosures) and a pre-inspection checklist and mock audit — so an affiliation/renewal inspection goes smoothly. Use it before an inspection. For the self-assessment at affiliation stage use the Affiliation Self-Assessment Audit tool.

Be ready for a board inspection

How the output is used

Use the tool to be ready for a board inspection and to meet the bye-laws.

Important cautions

Affiliation bye-laws are updated periodically and inspections check ongoing compliance (safety, staff, salary norms, records); maintain readiness year-round, not just before an inspection. Confirm current bye-laws.
