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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a school franchise/management MOU with each term separate — brand and curriculum licence, fees/royalty, roles and control, quality and brand standards, and term/exit — so a franchise or management arrangement (running a branded school) is clear and the brand is protected. Use it for a franchise/chain tie-up. For the business plan use the School Business Plan tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Structure a school franchise or management tie-up

How the output is used

Use the draft to structure a school franchise or management tie-up — brand, fees, roles and quality.

Who receives it

The franchisor/brand and the school owner — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; franchise/royalty fees as agreed.

Who should vet it

A franchise lawyer, for the brand, fee, territory and exit clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; the school entity must be run not-for-profit and meet affiliation norms even under a franchise; clarify who bears compliance and child-safety responsibility. A lawyer should review this significant arrangement.
