Background

Designs a learning-outcomes and data system — defining outcomes/competencies by grade, assessing and tracking learning (including foundational literacy/numeracy), analysing gaps, and driving intervention — so the school manages learning by evidence, not assumption. Use it to build a learning-data culture. For result analysis use the Result Analysis & Improvement tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Measure and improve what children actually learn

How the output is used

Use the system to measure and improve what children actually learn.

Important cautions

Track competencies and foundational skills to catch struggling children early, but keep it teacher-usable and humane — do not over-test or reduce children to data points. The goal is timely support.
