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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Designs a parent-teacher meeting system — frequency and format, structured sharing of academic and holistic progress, an action-oriented conversation, and follow-up — so PTMs are meaningful, not just report-card handovers. Use it to improve PTMs. For ongoing communication use the Parent Communication System tool.

Purpose of this tool & output

Run PTMs that actually help the child

How the output is used

Use the system to run PTMs that actually help the child.

Important cautions

A PTM should be a two-way, action-focused conversation about the whole child, not a rushed marks handover; schedule slots to respect everyone time and follow up on agreed actions.
