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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Guides obtaining state education-department recognition and the No-Objection Certificate needed before board affiliation — eligibility, documents, inspection and the process — so you complete the state-level step correctly. Use it before applying to a board. For affiliation itself use the Board Affiliation Guide.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get state recognition and the NOC for affiliation

How the output is used

Use the guide to get state recognition and the NOC required before board affiliation.

Who receives it

The State Education Department (through the District Education Officer/DEO).

How to submit / file it

Apply for state recognition and the NOC with the land, building, safety and staffing documents; an inspection follows.

Fees & charges

State recognition/NOC fees (as prescribed by the state).

Who should vet it

An education-compliance consultant.

Important cautions

Recognition and NOC processes are state-specific and change; confirm the current process with your state education department. The board NOC is a prerequisite for affiliation.
