Background

Guides managing the RTE 25% EWS/disadvantaged-group admissions — eligibility and documents, the state online lottery process, seat reporting, non-discrimination in class, and fee-reimbursement claims — so you meet a legal obligation correctly and claim reimbursement. Use it for RTE compliance. For the overall policy use the Admission Policy Builder.

Manage EWS/DG quota admissions compliantly

Use the tool to manage EWS/DG (RTE 25%) quota admissions compliantly.

RTE 25% is a legal obligation for private unaided schools with a state-run process; ensure full non-discriminatory inclusion and follow the state process. Reimbursement rules/delays vary by state.
