

Safety & Mandatory Certificates Guide

School Administration

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Guides obtaining the mandatory safety and health certificates a school needs — fire safety NOC, building stability/safety certificate, water potability and sanitation/health certificate — with the process for each, since these gate recognition and affiliation. Use it to plan certification. For the safety plan use the School Safety & Security Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Get fire, building, water and health certificates

How the output is used

Use the guide to obtain the mandatory fire, building, water and health certificates the board and state require.

Who receives it

The Fire Department, the local municipal/building authority, and the health department.

How to submit / file it

Apply for the fire NOC, building-safety/structural-stability, water-potability and health certificates from each authority.

Fees & charges

Fees per authority; inspection and consultant charges extra.

Who should vet it

An architect/consultant, with each issuing department.

Important cautions

Safety certificates are prerequisites for recognition/affiliation and for child safety; requirements vary by state/municipality and change. Confirm with local authorities and never operate without valid fire safety.
