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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Draft a mutual NDA for a security/FM context — protecting client site layouts, security arrangements, access details, CCTV footage and business information shared during a contract or bid. Fill in the parties and scope below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Protect client and site information

How the output is used

Use the draft to protect client and site information — a security/FM NDA (mutual or one-way) — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The NDA is between your firm and the client/partner; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on plain or nominal stamp paper; the definition of confidential information (site, security, personal data) and the term are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the scope, term and carve-out clauses before you handle sensitive site data.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have a lawyer review before signing.
