Background

Draft an enrollment/membership agreement between a sports academy/facility and a member (or parent for a minor) — program and fees, refund, code of conduct, liability waiver and medical/emergency consent — for a clear, protected engagement. Fill in the terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Clear terms for players and parents

How the output is used

Use the draft for clear terms with players and parents — fees, schedule, liability, safety and cancellation — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the academy/club and the player or parent/guardian; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on plain paper or as accepted terms; the fee, liability-waiver and cancellation terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the liability-waiver, medical-consent and cancellation clauses before you rely on it.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; include waiver, medical-consent and (for minors) parental terms and have a lawyer review before use.
