Background

Draft a franchise agreement for a sports academy/facility brand — territory and brand, fees/royalty, standards (coaching quality, safety, child protection) and support — to expand a sports-business network. Fill in the terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Franchise an academy or facility brand

How the output is used

Use the draft to franchise an academy or facility brand — fees, territory, standards, brand use and term — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the franchisor and the franchisee; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act where applicable; the franchise fee, royalty, territory and term are the key commercial content.

Who should vet it

A franchise lawyer, to check the fee, royalty, territory and termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; enforce coaching-quality and child-safeguarding standards on franchisees and have a lawyer review.
