Background

Draft a vendor agreement for a sports-business supplier (equipment/kit, turf/maintenance, or a service) — products/services and pricing, quality, delivery and warranty — for reliable supply. Fill in the terms below.

Use the draft to contract equipment and service vendors — scope, price, quality, delivery and liability — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the sports business and the vendor; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act where applicable; GST is handled in invoicing, and the price, quality and delivery terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the quality, price, liability and termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have a lawyer review before signing.
