

Colocation / PoP Hosting Agreement

Background

Draft a colocation/PoP hosting agreement — rack/space and power, cross-connects, access and security, SLA and support, and charges — between a facility provider and an operator hosting network equipment. Fill in the deal terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Host equipment in a data centre or PoP

How the output is used

Use the draft to host equipment in a data centre or PoP — space, power, access, SLA and liability; have a lawyer review.

Who receives it

The data-centre/PoP host and the customer (you) — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state on the agreement; no government filing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer for the power, access, SLA and liability clauses.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have it legally reviewed.
