Who receives it

The access providers (Jio, Airtel, Vi, BSNL) that operate the TRAI-mandated DLT (Distributed Ledger Technology) platforms under the TCCCPR 2018.

How to submit / file it

Register your entity, headers (sender IDs) and message templates on any operator DLT portal or through an aggregator, with your PAN/GST and consent/scrubbing details.

Fees & charges

A one-time entity registration fee plus per-header and per-template charges set by the DLT platform.

Who should vet it

Your telemarketer/aggregator or the DLT platform support desk.
