Background

Draft a passive infrastructure sharing agreement between an infrastructure provider and a telecom operator — shared elements, charges and escalation, access and O&M responsibilities, SLAs and liability. Fill in the deal terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Share tower or fibre infrastructure cleanly

How the output is used

Use the draft to share tower or fibre passive infrastructure cleanly — scope, charges, access and liability; have a lawyer confirm.

Who receives it

The infrastructure provider and the sharing operator(s) — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state on the agreement; no separate government filing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer to align scope and liability with the IP-I registration and licence conditions.
