Background

Draft an interconnect/peering agreement between two networks — points of interconnect, traffic and capacity, settlement or settlement-free basis, technical standards, SLAs and liability. Fill in the deal terms below.

Purpose of this tool & output

Exchange traffic with another network cleanly

How the output is used

Use the draft to exchange traffic with another network cleanly — peering/transit terms, points, capacity and settlement; have a lawyer review.

Who receives it

Your network and the interconnecting network operator — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state on the agreement; no separate government filing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer to align peering/transit and settlement terms with the TRAI interconnect regulations.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; have it legally reviewed.
