The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting (MIB); MSO registration is done on the Broadcast Seva portal.

How to submit / file it

Apply online on Broadcast Seva with company incorporation documents, network and headend/DAS details, subscriber-management-system particulars and the prescribed forms.

Fees & charges

An MSO registration fee per MIB norms, plus periodic renewal fees.

Who should vet it

A broadcast/cable compliance consultant or a company secretary familiar with MSO registration.
