Who receives it

The site owner/operator (you) and the O&M maintenance contractor — both sign; a copy for each party.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state on the contract; no government filing.

Who should vet it

A lawyer for the SLA, penalty and spares/liability clauses.
