

Export Sales Contract

Background

Get a solid export sales contract — a clause-by-clause draft covering goods and specs, price and Incoterm, payment (LC or TT), delivery and shipment, inspection and AQL, quality and claims, force majeure and governing law and arbitration, plus schedules. Have an export or legal expert review. Fill in your details below.

Purpose of this tool & output

A solid contract for international orders

How the output is used

Use the draft for a solid export sales contract on price, Incoterms, quality, payment and dispute terms.

Who receives it

The exporter and the overseas buyer — both sign; a copy each.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state; export of goods is generally zero-rated under GST (with LUT/refund).

Who should vet it

An international-trade lawyer, for the Incoterms, payment-security and jurisdiction clauses.
