Start exporting with the right registrations — IEC from DGFT, RCMC from AEPC or the relevant council, AD code with your bank and LUT for GST, with a council note and getting-started steps in order. Fill in your details below.

How the output is used

Use the guide to get your Import-Export Code (IEC) and the base registrations to start exporting.

Who receives it

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) for the IEC; AEPC/apparel council for RCMC where needed.

How to submit / file it

Apply for the IEC on the DGFT portal with PAN, Aadhaar and bank details; register with the apparel export council (RCMC) where required.

Fees & charges

A nominal IEC fee; RCMC has its own council fee.

Who should vet it

An EXIM/apparel-export consultant, for the registrations you need.
