

Broker / Booking Agent Agreement

Transport & Fleet

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a broker/booking-agent agreement with each term separate — role and territory, commission basis, payment collection responsibility, liability for bad loads/non-payment, and term/termination — so agent relationships do not cause payment disputes. Use it to engage brokers/agents. For finding loads use the Load Matching & Return-Load Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

Engage a load broker or booking agent cleanly

How the output is used

Use the draft to engage a load broker or booking agent — scope, commission, payment, liability and no-poach with discrete terms — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between your firm and the broker/booking agent; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on nominal stamp paper; the commission, payment-flow and liability terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the commission, payment-flow, liability and no-poach clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; clarify collection and non-payment liability precisely and have a lawyer review.
