Background

Compares buying, leasing and attaching owner-driver vehicles for capacity — capital, monthly cost, control, risk and tax — and recommends the mix. Use it when adding capacity. For the loan itself use the Vehicle Loan Structuring tool.

Use it to decide own, lease or attach owner-drivers — a buy-versus-lease-versus-attach analysis on cash, control and cost with a recommendation.

Who should vet it

Your CA, to confirm the cash, utilisation and cost assumptions behind the own-versus-lease-versus-attach call.
