Background

Writes a fleet-wide safety policy — safety responsibilities, vehicle standards, driver rules, journey management, incident reporting and review — so safety is systematic, not incidental. Use it as your safety backbone. For driver-specific rules use the Driver Safety & Conduct Policy.

How the output is used

Use it to set a fleet-wide safety framework and standards — a fleet safety policy across driving, vehicle, cargo and incident standards.

Who receives it

The policy applies to all drivers and operations staff and is acknowledged by them; a copy is kept on record.

Adapt to your operation; for hazmat follow specific rules and PESO/ADR-equivalent norms.
