

Owner-Driver Attachment Agreement

Transport & Fleet

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts an owner-driver vehicle attachment agreement with each term separate — vehicle, payout basis (per-trip/per-km/monthly), who bears fuel/toll/maintenance, documents, duration and termination — so attaching capacity does not turn into disputes. Use it to attach owner-driver trucks. For your own hired drivers use the Driver Employment Agreement.

Purpose of this tool & output

Attach an owner-driver vehicle on clear discrete terms

How the output is used

Use the draft to attach an owner-driver vehicle — rate, trips, fuel, maintenance responsibility and liability with discrete terms — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between your firm and the owner-driver; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Stamp duty per your state stamp act where applicable; the rate, responsibility split and liability terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the responsibility-split, liability and termination clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; a lawyer should review, and keep the contractor relationship genuinely independent.
