

Fleet Safety Audit

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This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Runs a structured fleet safety audit — vehicles, drivers, documents, journey management, incident record and systems — scoring each area and giving prioritised fixes with a corrective action plan. Use it for a periodic safety review or a client audit. For the policy use the Fleet Safety Policy.

Purpose of this tool & output

Score your safety and find the gaps

How the output is used

Use it to score your safety and find the gaps — a fleet safety audit that rates driving, vehicle and process safety against best practice.

Who should vet it

A fleet safety consultant, to validate the audit findings and corrective actions before you rely on them.

Important cautions

An honest self-audit only helps if the fixes are actually done; re-audit after action.
