This guide explains what the tool produces, how to use the output, and what to watch for. The actual output (draft/report) is generated on the tool page.

Background

Drafts a school transport service agreement — each term separate: routes and fees, safety commitments (GPS, attendant, verified drivers), pick-drop responsibility, liability and safeguarding, and term/termination — for a school or parent body. Use it for school-transport contracts. For the safety plan use the School Transport Safety Plan.

Purpose of this tool & output

School/parent transport contract with discrete terms

How the output is used

Use the draft for a school or parent transport contract — route, fee, safety duty, attendant and liability with discrete terms — reviewed by a lawyer.

Who receives it

The agreement is between the transporter and the school or parents; each keeps a signed copy.

Fees & charges

Usually on nominal stamp paper; the safety-duty, fee and liability terms are the key content.

Who should vet it

A lawyer, to check the safety-duty, child-safety and liability clauses before signing.

Important cautions

AI-generated draft; align with your state school-bus rules and have a lawyer review. Child safety obligations are legally serious.
