Purpose of this tool & output

IATA, associations and Ministry of Tourism recognition

How the output is used

Use it to get IATA, association and Ministry of Tourism recognition — the accreditations that let you issue air tickets and win trust.

Who receives it

Accreditation is granted by IATA (for air ticketing), the Ministry of Tourism (recognised travel agent / tour operator) and travel associations, as applicable.

How to submit / file it

Apply with the entity, office, financials, staff qualifications and, for IATA, a bank guarantee; verification precedes accreditation.

Fees & charges

Accreditation/registration fees per body plus the IATA bank guarantee; accreditations are renewed periodically.

Who should vet it

A travel-accreditation consultant and the concerned body (IATA / Ministry of Tourism), which verify the entity before accreditation.

Important cautions

Criteria and fees change; confirm current requirements with IATA/associations/Ministry of Tourism.
