Who receives it

The State Pollution Control Board (BMW authorization) and the authorised BMW disposal operator.

How to submit / file it

Obtain BMW authorization, segregate and store waste per the BMW Rules, hand over to the authorised operator and file returns.

Fees & charges

A fee per the state rules; the disposal operator charges separately.

Who should vet it

An environmental/BMW consultant, for the authorization and disposal chain.
